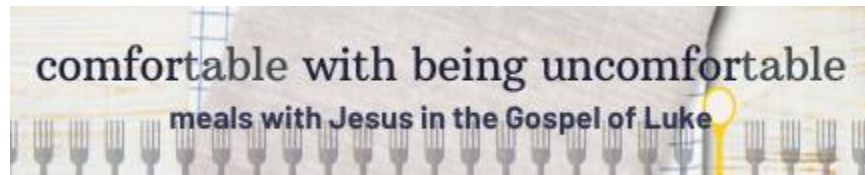

Sunday Morning Adult Classes The Adult Education Committee is excited to tell you about our new class for Sunday mornings starting September 11, "The Bible: God's Story-Our Story". We want to facilitate and encourage informed reading of the Bible while also encouraging folks to see the Bible as God's revelation to us that is alive and active even today. We are not undertaking a 'study of the Bible' per se. Paul Watson and Carl Holladay will lead a large group class helping us see the big picture of the Bible looking at both Old and New Testaments. We will meet in Care Groups the other sessions and have discussions during which we will look at scriptures that exemplify or focus on some of the major points. The Care Group teachers will guide us in a discussion about the passage, and will give questions and techniques that we can then use on our own as we read God's word. Here is the September schedule:
